Inarhyme Records recording artist Mark Lomax is a drummer/composer/bandleader/educator who has led his own groups and has been featured as a member of the Marlon Jordan Quintet, Delfeayo Marsalis Sextet, Ellis Marsalis Quintet and Azar Lawrence Quintet. He has also performed with jazz legend Clark Terry, as well as saxophonists Billy Harper, Bennie Maupin, Victor Goines and Wessel "Warm Daddy" Anderson. Lomax has also toured with many local and regional bands playing a wide variety of styles, from folk, blues and rock to funk, gospel, R&B and hip-hop. As a composer, he has written jazz, gospel and classical works, and his orchestral arrangements of gospel songs have been played by the Nashville Symphony Orchestra and National Symphony Orchestra, as well as the Czech National Symphony. He produced eight recordings for his BMR label that range from traditional and more avant-garde jazz to gospel music for children before signing with Inarhyme and has a new project that will be released in February 2014. Lomax is an ABD candidate for the Doctor of Music Arts in composition at Ohio State University.
